Fredrik Söderberg Fredrik Söderberg's art is usually based on a thorough investigation of historical periods and a history of ideas. In addition to a strong visual experience, the viewer is also forced into a thoughtful reflection. Fredrik Söderberg works in large series. The works vary in format, from relatively small to large. The figurative paintings are full of beautiful details that form a grand whole. His abstract paintings fascinate with their exquisite colour and harmonious composition. In intricate ornaments of silver, gold and coloured bands, we see figurative and abstract forms in which matter and spirit meet.

Jongsuk Yoon In spring 2020, monumental murals by the Korean German artist Jongsuk Yoon is shown in the largest exhibition hall at The Nordic Watercolour Museum. The artist imbues the works with her personal presence. The paintings are developed during meditation and deep concentration. Her muted colours and frequent changes in perspective, landscape elements and gestures are reminiscent of Asian calligraphy. Jongsuk Yoon describes her creative process as a communication with the painting. "My ideas – she says – take shape on the canvas as I paint. The finished image is not in my head. It is the painting itself that tells me what to do."
